

Introduction

I've always been interested in family history and in the 1980's I began a more detailed search. My "breakthrough" was meeting Kate Ferguson of Kenbridge, who had already done significant research on the Powers line. It was the start, and remains the backbone, of this effort. I also should credit Irving Powers of Kensington, MD for his help. In addition, I must thank the dozens of family members who've shared information that made this book possible.

Some of the information here comes from others who have posted their Powers genealogy on Ancestry.com. There is a great deal of primary data there, but also research that isn't well documented. I've tried to be selective with what I take as fact and what is speculation. Nevertheless, I'm sure there are mistakes and omissions in this book. I acknowledge they are mine alone. I've tried to indicate areas where the proof is thin but as one travels back in time there seem to be a lot of people with the same name in the same area.

I also ask that my readers acknowledge that the Powers family was a product of its time. There are slave-holders, horse-traders and some folks with less than a complete education. Some were church-going and some were not. And some were so busy trying to scratch out a living in the soil of Mecklenburg and Lunenburg Counties that they didn't stop to write everything down.

I have elected to publish information through my parents' generation (the 8th generation from the immigrant Sampson Power) with the names of their children. However, in a nod to privacy, I've gone no further. I do have a good bit of that information and hope to pass it along to my children with the hope someone gets the "genealogy bug." Perhaps they will update this book at some point in the future.

Chapter One: The Power/Powers Family in France, England & Ireland

The Power/Powers name began as le Poer and changed slowly to Poer, Power and eventually Powers. The le Poer name derived from the old French word "povre" (Latin pauper, poor, or someone who took a vow of poverty).¹

The le Poers were Normans (French) who came to England in 1066 with William the Conqueror and the name is found on a tablet at Battle Abbey listing prominent survivors of the battle of Hastings. This family moved on to Ireland when Sir Robert De Poer invaded with Strongbow in 1172. This was an effort to secure Ireland for King Henry II.²

King Henry II's authority for invading Ireland rested on Pope Adrian which granted Ireland to Henry. The Pope, the only Englishman ever to occupy St. Peter's chair, refers to the king's purpose "to enlarge the boundaries of the Church, to proclaim the truths of the Christian religion to a rude and ignorant people, and to root out the growths of vice from the field of the Lord." ³

In 1172, King Henry II granted by charter to Robert De Poer, the County Waterford, with "the whole province thereabouts;" and made him Marshall of Ireland. In the year

1179, this Robert De Poer was joined in commission with Sir Hugo De Lacy, as Lord Justices of Ireland.⁴

There is a more detailed biography of Robert le Poer written by his 18th great-grandson, Eamonn Murphy of Dunhill.⁵

By the Victorian era, it would appear some of the Poer family tried to rewrite the name's history for reasons of snobbery. The "...surname [le Poer], meaning `the poor man', may have been the result of taking a vow of holy poverty rather than just being impecunious. In the last century [i.e., the 19th century], when poverty was considered a stigma, the head of the Power family changed his name to de Poher de la Poer and made a valiant but unconvincing attempt to trace his descent from the fifth-century counts of a district in Brittany called Poher." ⁶

The Genealogical Resource Center (cproots.com) confirms the original name was, in fact, le Poer.

It is most likely our ancestors were not from either line (Poer or Poher) that traces back to France but originated from Irish (and some transplanted Scots and English) serfs who worked the land on estates belonging to the le Poer family. It was common for the people who worked these estates to take the name of the estate owner. So, it's possible we trace back to the aristocracy of France/England/Ireland. But let's be honest, it seems more likely our ancestors were those "rude and ignorant people." It was largely this group of people, seeking to escape poverty and warfare, who emigrated to America.

In a side note, it is quite possible that the Terrell and Gee families, who marry into the Powers family, are from the aristocracy. And one researcher traces our Terrell line back to King James I of England.

The Power (le Pour) name is more numerous in County Waterford than anywhere else. In fact, nearly half their total is in that county and Power heads the statistical list for County Waterford. The remainder, apart from the city of Dublin, which contains people from all the provinces, are for the most part in counties that adjoin Waterford.

The le Poer family built "Dunhill Castle" (below) in the early 1200's on a cliff overlooking the River Anne outside the small village of Dunhill, 2 miles south of Waterford, Ireland. The le Poer family reportedly launched attacks on the city of Waterford during the 14th century and in 1345 they were counter-attacked, taken prisoner and many hanged.



By 1649 Dunhill Castle passed into the hands of the Powers of Kilmeaden (cousins) who supported the King. Forces loyal to

Oliver Cromwell captured Dunhill Castle and destroyed much of the structure.

By the 1700's weather and time had taken its toll. And in 1912, the east wall of the castle collapsed during a storm. ^{7 8}

There is a large Tudor-Baronial house located near Kilsheelan, County of Waterford referred to as "Gurteen Le Poer." It was built in 1866 for Edmond, 1st Count de la Poer.





The information on the home (above) and its ties to Sir Rober Le Poer are detailed by Lord Belmont and show the many descendants and their role in English and Irish history. This history does not show any immigrants to America. ⁹

There is a famous Powers Whiskey that is produced in Dublin and is the first Irish whiskey to be bottled. The firm was founded in 1791 by James Power, an innkeeper. It is considered one of the big four makers of Irish whiskey. It is the best-selling whiskey in Ireland.



The family motto is *Per Crucem ad coronam* – "By the cross, to a crown."



The Power/Powers "Coat of Arms" or family "Shield" has appeared in several variations. The one shown above left is the most accepted shield and shows a quarter length black jagged pattern on a white field. It is one of the plainer Irish Clan coat of arms but is unmistakable.

This is the crest used for the "Power clan gathering" in Waterford every three years.

The crest above right is one of many variations that include such added items like "helm" and "wreath" and "supporters." As you can see the simple "shield" is the basis for the design.

We can find no argument that the generations of the Power/Powers family in America trace directly back to the Power clan in Ireland for whom the shield is appropriate. However, like many others, we simply associate ourselves with a Power/Powers "Coat of Arms."

Chapter Two: The Power/Powers Family in America

Our Power/Powers ancestors were likely part of a migration of some 250,000 people who came to the "new world" in the 17th and 18th century. Some were Protestant merchants and tenant farmers who had been settled in Ireland by the British government and arrived speaking English. Most, however, were Irish. They were largely Presbyterian. The largest migration came as the ruling British tried to force them into the "Church of England." They would later call themselves "Scotch-Irish" (More properly Scot-Irish") because they didn't want to be confused with the 19th century Irish immigrants who were largely Catholic and settled mostly in eastern cities. ¹⁰

It appears that both Walter Powers and Sampson Power (described below) were Protestant. Both seem to fit the "Scotch-Irish" description.

Walter Powers (1639-1708)¹¹ is a key figure in the New England branch of the Powers clan, as many can trace their lineage back to him. He was 14 when he left the Old World in 1654, and settled on land in Concord Village, now within the town of Littleton, MA, adjoining the Indian plantation of Nashoba. He is listed in the Middlesex County, MA, records in 1654 as a boy of 14 years of age. Unquestionably his place of birth is Waterford, Ireland. It appears more than likely that Walter was an indentured servant who escaped famine in Ireland to settle in the New World.

After settling in Concord Village (now Littleton, MA), Walter worked for Ralph Shepard, a Puritan minister who escaped religious persecution in England. After six years (about the time it took to work off the cost of transportation from Ireland), Walter married his master's daughter, Trial Shepard. County records list the date on "ye eleventh day of ye first month, 1660, to Trial, daughter of Deacon Ralph and Thankes."

Walter and his new bride, Trial, established a large family of seven sons and two daughters, many of whom lived in and around the Littleton, MA, area for nearly five generations, with very active involvement in the civic and economic activities of their communities. Walter established a family household and sawmill on a tract of land that consisted of one fourth of the Indian village of Nashoba. Walter obtained this land from his former master and now father-in-law, Deacon Ralph Shepard, who purchased the whole village of Nashoba from Thomas Waban and other Indians.

I've not found any connection between Walter Powers in New England and the "Southern Branch" of the Power family.

Chapter Three: The Southern Branch

We know with some certainty that our line traces back to Henry Powers (1809-1884) and to his father William (About 1770 – About 1756) and to his father Sampson Power. But there appear to be two Williams and maybe two Sampsons.

Which Sampson?

We are certain the Sampson Powers who died in Mecklenburg County in 1813 is the father of a William Powers. William's marriage record lists him as the "...son of Sampson Power." And William is the father of Henry Power who we know to be our family line.

Sampson of Princess Anne County, son of Samuel, son of Sampson (the Immigrant)

There is a Sampson Powers (son of Samuel, son of Sampson) who was born in Princess Anne County (now Virginia Beach) before 1729 and we believe he is the Sampson Powers who died in Mecklenburg County in 1813 and is the ancestor of our Powers line.

We believe this Sampson is the son of Samuel Power and Amy Butt.

In turn, Samuel is the son of Sampson Power Sr. who arrived in "Lower Norfolk" (now Virginia Beach) about 1681.¹³

This Sampson Power is one of 60 persons transported to America by Thomas Fenwick. Fenwick is the man who gets the

"headright" of land for Power's transportation. Fenwick is a gentleman, son of Walter Fenwick of Atwick in York (England). Thomas Fenwick gets two pieces of land in the Norfolk area and a large parcel of land in Maryland, where he eventually settles and becomes a government official.¹⁴

Sampson (son of Samuel, son of Sampson, Sr) has a brother and sisters and, we believe, half brothers and sisters by Samuel's second wife Mary.¹⁵

We show the Sampson in Mecklenburg and wife Sarah (last name unknown) in the period 1750 to 1800, with a son William, who has a son Henry.

Sampson, son of Joseph and Sarah Franklin

There may be another Sampson Powers who may have been born in Mecklenburg County in 1750. There is a Sampson shown as the son of Joseph Powers and Sarah Franklin. Both are shown as being from Kilkenny, Ireland. But there appear to be at least two options for these parents.

Sampson may be the son of Joseph Powers (1711-1809) and Sarah Franklin (1717-) This Joseph was born in 1711 or 1712 in Northumberland County, VA and died in Spartanburg, SC in 1809. Sarah Franklin was born in 1717 in Kilkenny, Ireland and dies in Chesterfield County, VA. Their son Sampson (wife Sarah) has a son William (1749-1822) but this William (wife Sarah) is shown with no

son Henry. And William is shown as dying in Weakly, Tennessee. 16

Or this Sampson is the son of Joseph Power (1720-1809) born in Kilkenny, Ireland and Sarah Franklin (1730-). This line also shows a son William (with the same birth and death dates) but with a wife Elizabeth Johnson. He has sons who are born in North Carolina and die in Tennessee. A variation on this version goes to a William who marries Judith Beluse (1772-1853). This William appears to be in Laurens, South Carolina (his children are born there). There is no son Henry. 18

Both of these lines have Sampson born in Mecklenburg of Irish parents and the only primary documentation I can find is "The American Genealogical-Biographical Index" which simply lists him as being born in Virginia but show the James/Sarah parents. This may be the Sampson who is the father of "William of Tennessee" discussed below.

Which William?

There appear to be two William Powers. We believe some people have merged some aspects of one with the other and created one person or at least mixed parts of one with the other. Both claim a Sampson Power of Mecklenburg as the father.

William of Tennessee

This William Powers is almost certainly not our line. He is shown as being born in Virginia in 1770 but no specific location is given and dying in Weakley, TN in 1880 or 1885. Other than records showing Sampson and Sarah of Mecklenburg as the parents, and one of several marriage records showing William and Elizabeth being married in Lunenburg County, there aren't many records tying him to Mecklenburg.

His parents are shown as Sampson and Sarah with both parents dying in Mecklenburg. These are the same parents we show for William of Mecklenburg. There is a possibility there is another Sampson Power.

Only one record has him marrying Elizabeth Crafton Palmer in 1808 in Lunenburg. We cannot find any documents that supports this marriage for this William.

Most have him marrying Elizabeth Johnson (1768-1845) in several locations; On 10 Nov 1808 in Lunenburg; 29 Nov 1774 in Louisa (she would have been only 6 if her birth date is correct); on 13 Aug 1790 in Johnston County, NC; or on 10 Mar 1800 in Duplin, NC.

This William Powers is shown in Weakley, TN on the tax records 1842 (tax book, District 6). This William Powers is in Weakley, TN in the census of 1850, He is shown as 80 years old, living in a home with what appears to be his son, 45-year-old C. Powers and his wife and three children. This William has eight children including a Joseph Henry (1803-1884) and an Allen (1813-1880). This Joseph Henry is not our Henry as he married Rachel Eliz Callihan.

All William's children appear to be born in or have ties to Tennessee.

Sources for almost all this William's information appear to be

other online Ancestry trees. There is very little primary supporting data.

William of Mecklenburg

He is shown born about 1770 in Mecklenburg County, VA with most records not showing a death location (however one says 1856 in Mecklenburg).

His parents are Sampson and Sarah with both parents dying in Mecklenburg. These are the same parents shown for the William who dies in Tennessee. However, we know Sampson and Sarah are this William's parents because the marriage record for Elizabeth Palmer refers to William as "the son of Sampson Power."

William first marries Dosha Farley (1773-1807) on 10 Dec 1796 in Lunenburg County. We believe there are five children (we have the names of three; Spencer, Sally and William Jr. ¹⁹

Dosha Farley Powers died about 1807.

He then marries Mary Elizabeth Crafton Palmer (possibly Parmer) (1786-1849) on 12 Nov 1808. She has one child by her first husband, John.²⁰

She and the son, Melcajah "Mel" Palmer, move into William Powers' home in Prince Edward County.

William and Mary Elizabeth have 8 children from 1809 thru 1833 including Henry (1809-1884). Henry is our line.

About 1831, after the death of William's mother, Sarah, William and Mary Elizabeth and their children move into the "Powers family home" back in Mecklenburg. The 8th child, John Robert Powers, is born there

The 1840 census shows him in the "East District" of Mecklenburg

County.

His second wife Mary Elizabeth dies about 1849.

The 1850 census shows him in "Regiment 98" of Mecklenburg County. He dies about 1856 in Mecklenburg County.

Chapter Four: Sampson Powers in Mecklenburg County

So, we start from the Sampson already in Mecklenburg, In the first census (The census of 1790), Sampson Power is living in Mecklenburg County, Virginia. By the standards of the day, he is prosperous, with three slaves and substantial property. He is literate and witnesses several wills. On adjacent farms, there are two other Powers families. There is William Powers with a family of seven persons and a Joseph Powers.

Mecklenburg County, Virginia Will Book #8, page 8:

"In the name of God Amen I Samson Powers of the County of Mecklenburg being of a perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for it and knowing that it is appointed of God for man once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following. Viz. First of all my will and desire is that all my just debts be truly paid. Item I lend unto my well-beloved wife Sarah Powers my whole estate in land, Negroes, money and bonds and with all the other property of every kind during her natural life or widowhood. Item on condition that my son Samuel Powers pays unto my two daughters Sally Curtis and Patsey Jackson five pounds in pure Virginia currency then at the death or marriage of my wife Sarah Powers I give to him the said Samuel Powers, the residue of my land on which I now live, together with an equal share (with my other three children) of every other part of my whole estate. Item my will and desire is at the death or marriage of my wife Sarah Powers or as soon after as my executors hereafter named shall think proper that they proceed and

have all my Negroes placed into four lots and then drawn for by my legatees and those of my heirs that shall draw that lot which is best or most naturable? shall pay to the others to make them equal and then my will and desire is that all my other property of every description whatsoever be sold and all the money arising therefrom be equally divided between my four children namely William Powers, Patsey Jackson, Sally Curtis and Samuel Powers to them or their heirs forever (Betsey Fagerson daughter of Flemming Jackson, deceased excluded for it is my will that she the said Betsey Fagerson should not heir anything of my estate forever). Item my will is that my son William Powers shall have in the division of my estate twenty-five pounds Virginia money less than my other children, by reason of property he has already received. Lastly, I appoint my wife Sarah Powers, executrix and Zachariah Curtis and Cavil Jackson, executors of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 25th day of February in the year of our lord 1813. Samson Powers. Signed and sealed in presence of: Sanford Bowers, Peter T. Fargeson

[Note: We start this genealogical section using the "modified register" format with this Sampson (grandson of the immigrant) as the "first" generation. The numbering that follows and the associated footnotes, are based on this.]

1. **Sampson Powers** was born before 1729 in Princess Anne County, Virginia, USA. He lived in Mecklenburg County, VA in 1782. He died on 13 Oct 1813 at the age of 84 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia.

We are convinced the Sampson Powers who died in Mecklenburg County in 1813 is the father of William Powers. William's marriage record lists him as the "...son of Sampson Power."

Sampson married **Sarah** (last name unknown) who was born about 1730 in Mecklenburg, Virginia. She died in 1831 at the age of 101 in Mecklenburg, Virginia.

Sampson Powers and Sarah had the following children:

- +2 i. Martha Patsey (Patty) Powers, born 1770, South Hill, Mecklenburg County, Virginia; married Cavil Jackson, 13 Mar 1801, Granville, North Carolina; married Fleming Jackson, 9 Oct 1792, Mecklenburg, Virginia; died 1826, Mecklenburg, Virginia.
- +3 ii. William Powers, born about 1770, Mecklenburg
 County, Virginia; married Dosha Farley, 10 Dec 1796,
 Lunenburg County, Virginia; married Mary Elizabeth
 Crafton, 10 Nov 1808, Lunenburg Co, Virginia; died
 about 1856, Mecklenburg County, Virginia.
- +4 iii. **Sally Ann Powers**, born about 1778, Mecklenburg Co., VA; married Zachariah Curtis Sr., 16 Feb 1795, Mecklenburg, Virginia; died 16 Apr 1851, Boydton, Mecklenburg, Virginia.
- +5 iv. **Samuel H. Powers**, born about 1786; married Selah Zachary, 1 Apr 1802, Lunenburg, Virginia; died about 1861.

Chapter Five: Second Generation

2. **Martha Patsey (Patty) Powers** (Sampson-1) was born in 1770 in South Hill, Mecklenburg County, Virginia. She died in 1826 at the age of 56 in Mecklenburg, Virginia.

Martha Patsey (Patty) Powers and Cavil Jackson were married on 13 Mar 1801 in Granville, North Carolina.^{2–3} **Cavil Jackson**, son of Matthew Jackson and Elizabeth Avery, was born on 9 Jun 1769 in Amelia Co., VA. He died in 1818 at the age of 49 in Mecklenburg, Virginia.

Cavil Jackson and Martha Patsey (Patty) Powers had the following children:

- 6 i. **Waddy J. Jackson** was born in Dec 1801 in Mecklenburg Co., VA. He died in 1857 at the age of 56 in Mecklenburg Co., VA.
- +7 ii. **Rebecca T. Jackson**, born Mecklenburg, Virginia; married William G. Hogan, 19 Dec 1825, Mecklenburg, Virginia.
 - 8 iii. **Samuel Jackson** was born in Mecklenburg, Virginia.
 - 9 iv. **Archer Jackson** was born about 1815 in Mecklenburg Co., VA. He died in 1880 at the age of 65 in Mecklenburg Co., VA.
- v. **Cavil Osborne Jackson** was born (date unknown).
- vi. **Green Jackson** died in 1836 in Mecklenburg Co.VA. He was born in Mecklenburg, Virginia.

Martha Patsey (Patty) Powers and Fleming Jackson (the brother of her first husband) were married on 9 Oct 1792 in Mecklenburg, Virginia.^{4–5} **Fleming Jackson**, son of Matthew James Jackson and

Elizabeth Avery, was born on 6 Jun 1766 in La Crosse, Mecklenburg, Virginia. He died on 7 Sep 1797 at the age of 31 in La Crosse, Mecklenburg, Virginia.

3. **William Powers** (Sampson-1) was born about 1770 in Mecklenburg County, VA.⁶

There is another William who dies in Weakley County, TN about this time but we believe "our" William is still in Mecklenburg County, VA about 1856 at the age of 86.

William Powers and Dosha Farley were married on 10 Dec 1796 in Lunenburg County, Virginia.⁵ **Dosha Farley**, daughter of Henry Farley and Anne Atkinson, was born in 1773 in Lunenburg County, Virginia. She died about 1807 at the age of 34 in Lunenburg County, Virginia.

William Powers and Dosha Farley had seven children; we have the names of three:

- i. **Spencer Powers** was born about 1798 in Prince Edward County, Virginia.
- +13 ii. **Sarah "Sally" Powers**, born 1802, Prince Edward County, Virginia; married Thomas Crafton, 14 Mar 1826, Lunenburg, Virginia; died about 1838, Lunenburg County, Virginia.
 - iii. **William Powers Jr** was born about 1805 in Prince Edward County, Virginia.

William Powers and Mary Elizabeth Crafton (widow of John Palmer, d. 1803-1808) were married on 10 Nov 1808 in Lunenburg Co, Virginia.⁸⁻⁹ **Mary Elizabeth Crafton**, daughter of Thomas Crafton and Mary Sammons, was born in 1786 in Lunenburg Co., VA.. After the death of his first wife, new wife Elizabeth Crafton and her

son, Mel, move with William to Prince Edward County. After the death of his mother they move into the Powers home in Mecklenburg County. She died about 1849 at the age of 63 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia.

William Powers and Mary Elizabeth Crafton had the following children:

Samuel is something of a mystery. Clearly Sampson has a son Samuel. In his will of 1813, Samuel is mentioned without reference to a middle name or initial. He is left with "the residue of my land on which I now live" (with some stipulations).

The census of 1810 has a Samuel Powers and a Samuel Powers, Jr. in Lunenburg County, VA We have located a Samuel (1786-1861) who fits the description and the dates. But we know little more. Some research shows him dying in Tennessee.

There is also a Samuel Weatherhead Powers (1797-26 Mar 1876) who dies in Riverton, Conn. We don't know much about him either. But if Dad left Samuel land in Mecklenburg, how did either end up in Connecticut or Tennessee?

Henry (along with Elizabeth Powers, Nancy Powers, Mary Ann Powers, William Powers and Robert Powers) sell some Lunenburg land to George Tucker on 4 Jul 1850 (DB 35, p.60). On 14 Feb 1852, he buys two adjacent parcels (DB 35, p.29). On 30 Sep 1854, Henry Powers buys 100 acres west of Flat Rock Creek (DB 35, p. 559) from David Garland.

In the census of 1880, Henry is shown as "widowed" and age 70. He is shown alone in the home.

Henry Powers left his entire estate to Della and children with his son, Benjamin, as agent and manager for Della. Benjamin died soon after his father's death. William Henry apparently already had his share of the land.

It is possible Della is not Benjamin's wife, as the 1880 census lists Della Powers (age 24) as Benjamin's Daughter-in-law, with three youngsters listed as Benjamin's granddaughters; Ariadna (age 1), Naddra J. (age 1) and Laura J. (age 3).

Della remarried and the Powers' land apparently passed over to them. Henry's will is WB#14, page 295.



William died on 26 Jul 1911 at the age of 79 in Lunenburg County, Virginia.³⁴ He is buried in Kenbridge,

He was originally buried on "the farm" (the Harvey S. Powers farm) in a cemetery plot in the middle of the garden. At the time of Harvey's death and the sale of "the farm," the grave of William Henry, his wife and Harvey Street's daughter, Louise, were moved to the Kenbridge cemetery.

Prior to the Civil War, Powers was an overseer on the William Ingram plantation, located on what is now Route 637 (Craig Mill Road) about 1500 feet North of the intersection with Route 636 (Whittles Mill Road). The building that served as Dr. Ingram's office still stands near the home. The original home burned and the current structure, we are told, is a much more modest building.

In the Civil War, William Henry Powers enlisted in the Confederate Army on 29 August 1861, only a few months after the war started. The enlistment is shown as taking place in Liberty, Virginia (now Bedford, VA). He is recruited by Captain Alexander Jordan who will serve as his Company Commander

through the war. This makes him a Private in Company E (Jordan's Co), 4th Regiment, Virginia Heavy Artillery (the Piedmont Battery).

We don't know much about the first few months of his enlistment but by the March/April muster (a report dated 30 June 1862) he is reported as "present" and his unit is in the Peninsula Campaign (between the James and York Rivers). These volunteer units (apparently not very well organized) were attempting to stop Union General George McClellan



from marching his army to Petersburg and Richmond. These Confederate units (some 23 brigades or 56,500 men) were forced to retreat on 3 May 1862. The retreat was at best confused and at worst, a disaster. Fifty-six guns, 53 of them undamaged, along with ammunition and supplies were left behind. General John Magruder is blamed and was replaced.

His unit report notes that "...owing to the confusion and hard times in its evacuation to Gloucester Point on the first of last May, the unit was not mustered as required by law."

On 31 May 1862, his unit is involved in the battle of Fair Oaks (sometimes called the battle of Seven Pines). In this series of

battles, marked by much confusion, the Confederates lost some 6,000 dead with some 5,000 Federals killed.

The unit is reassigned about September 1863 to an area around Charleston and it becomes Company E, 34th Regiment, Virginia Infantry. Captain Jordan is still in command. It is part of Wise's Brigade. Presumably since it lost (abandoned) its artillery in the retreat, it could no longer be an artillery unit.

By May 1864, these units return north to the defense of Richmond and Petersburg.

In the May/June 1864 Muster, General Wise reports "On the 10th of June (1864), we were ordered to the South (side) of the Appomattox (River) where we engaged the enemy on the 15th, 16th and 17th on our line of defenses east of Petersburg."

General Wise says his 2,200 men repulsed a force of 22,500 Federals (his estimates). In the final charge, "...the whole regiment left the parapets and gloriously repulsed them."

William Henry Powers is in the trenches around Petersburg for nine months and his unit is part of the famous battle of the Crater.

By March 1865, retreat seemed inevitable. Wise's Brigade moves to Lee's right and is involved in the battle of Saylor's Creek. During the retreat, General Wise reports that many officers and many men deserted.

When the units arrived at Appomattox, Lee surrendered and William Henry Powers is on the list of "prisoners of war, belonging to the Army of Northern Virginia, who have this day surrendered by General Robert E. Lee, C.S.A. Commanding said Army, to Lieut. General U.S. Grant, commanding Armies of the United States. Paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865. List dated HdQrs, Johnson's Div, April 10, 1865."

After the war, William Henry POWERS and his Uncle, Lee O.

Abernathy, begin buying land around Flat Rock Creek in Lunenburg County. On 11 Jan 1870, (DB 39, p.488), he makes the first of several purchases of the Ingram-tract, land that was once owned by Doctor William Ingram.

During the Civil War, we have been told, the Ingram sons were killed, the daughters, who lived in Petersburg during the war for fear of Yankee raids, did not return to Lunenburg.

At the time of his will, 17 Jul 1911, William Henry POWERS owned 496 acres, which he divides equally among his five children, with the exception of son John Powers. His share is left to John's wife Xenia Powers.





And the bed we're told was made for his wedding-night has been handed down to his great-great granddaughter Loren Powers.


